MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF GLENDALE, COLORADO

February 4, 2020
7:00 p.m.

Mayor Dunafon led the room in the Pledge of Allegiance.

1. Call to Order and Roll Call. Mayor Dunafon called the regular meeting of the Council to order. Veronica Marvin, City Clerk, called roll. The following Council Members were present: Rachel Binkley, Storm Gloor, Dario Katardzic, Lindsey Mintz, Ryan Tuchscherer and Mayor Pro Tem Rigoni. City Attorney Matt Giacomini, City Manager Linda Cassaday and members of City Staff also attended the meeting.
2. Approval of Agenda. Council Member Mintz moved to approve the agenda. This particular motion requires no second. There was unanimous consent of the Council.
3. Preliminary Staff Matters. There was none.
4. Public Comments. Steven Binder, Managing Director, Robert W. Baird & Co., praised Captain Gross and Sargent Baumgartner for their Active Shooter presentation at Baird & Co.

Mayor Dunafon read the matter into record by title only, all Council Members having received copies of the same. Chief Haskins recommended approval of the new manager. Mayor Pro Tem Rigoni motioned to approve the new manager. Council Member Katardzic seconded the motion, and the motion passed unanimously.

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Council Member Katardzic motioned to approve Consent Items. Council Member Mintz seconded the motion, and the motion passed unanimously.

8. Public Hearing on Special Event Permit for The Hellenic Orthodox Community of Denver, 4610 East Alameda Avenue, Event: Tigray Ethiopian Community Association on February 23, 2020, 6:00 p.m. to 1:00 a.m. Event Manager: Abey Hailelassie. Mayor Dunafon read the matter into record by title only and opened the public hearing, all Council Members having received copies of the same. Chief Haskins recommended approval of the special event permit. Mayor Dunafon closed the public hearing. Council Member Katardzic motioned to approve the special event permit. Mayor Pro Tem Rigoni seconded the motion, and the motion passed unanimously.
9. Resolution No. 3, Series of 2020, A Resolution Of The City Council Of The City Of Glendale, Colorado Authorizing The City Clerk To Appoint Election Judges For The April 7, 2020 Regular Municipal Election. Mayor Dunafon read the matter into record by title only, all Council Members having received copies of the same. Deputy City Manager, Chuck Line, explained this will allow the City Clerk to appoint judges for the upcoming election. Veronica Marvin, City Clerk, added that this will be a polling place election. Council Member Mintz motioned to approve the resolution. Mayor Pro Tem Rigoni seconded the motion, and the motion passed unanimously.

Introduction of Ordinance No. 2, Series of 2020, an Ordinance of the City Council of the City of Glendale, Amending Chapter 3.28 Of The Glendale Code Of Ordinances To Allow For The Licensing And Operation Of Marijuana Hospitality Establishments And Marijuana Hospitality And Sales Establishments, Regulating Their Location, Authorizing Smoking Of Marijuana In Said Establishments, And Enacting Reasonable Operational Requirments Including A Process For License Issuance Consistent With Colorado Marijuana Statutes And Regulations And The Colorado Constitution. Mayor Dunafon introduced the matter into record by title only and announced that he and Council Member Mintz were recusing themselves and handed the gavel to Mayor Pro Tem Rigoni. Mayor Dunafon and Council Member Mintz left the dais and the room. Deputy City Manager, Chuck Line, explained that these new licenses will be located in areas of already existing retail and medical marijuana licensed establishments and within the existing space with specific regulations and requirements. There was no one signed up for Public Comments. Council Member Tuchscherer motioned to approve the ordinance. Council Member Binkley seconded the motion, and the motion passed unanimously.
