City Attorney Matt Giacomini, City Manager Linda Cassaday and members of City Staff also attended the meeting.


Subject: Discuss and review the public safety implications of Colorado Senate Bill 21-62 for the citizens, visitors, and businesses in Glendale and issue a resolution or position regarding the support, opposition, or recommendation to amend the Bill. Mayor Dunafon read the matter into the record. Deputy City Manager Chuck Line detailed the provisions proposed in the bill. Chief Haskins said the bill was unamendable and should not get passed. City of Glendale's Government Affairs Specialist R.D. Sewald addressed council, discussing the ramifications of the bill and recommended to oppose its passage.

Council Member Mintz made a motion to draft a statement of opposition of Senate Bill 21-62 on the city's behalf. Council Member Katardzic seconded the motion, and the motion passed unanimously.

The meeting adjourned at 6:04 p.m.


