Ordinance No. 4, Series of 2020, An Ordinance Of The City Council Of The City Of Glendale, Colorado Allowing Additional Temporary Signs For Uses In The City Without A Permit For The Duration Of The Disaster Emergency And Declaring An Emergency. Mayor Dunafon read the matter into record by title only, all Council Members having received copies of the same. Deputy City Manager, Chuck Line, explained this emergency ordinance will allow businesses additional temporary signage to inform the public know they are open for business. Council Member Katardzic motioned to approve the ordinance. Council Member Gloor seconded the motion, and the motion passed unanimously.

Ordinance No. 5, Series of 2020, An Ordinance Of The City Council Of The City Of Glendale, Colorado Delegating As The Local Liquor License Authority Certain Authority, Designating The City Manager As A Hearing Officer Over Temporary Modification Of Liquor Licensed Premises, And Allowing Modification Hearings To Be Conducted Remotely And Electronically During The Disaster Emergency To Encourage Implementation Of Physical Distancing Requirements And Declaring An Emergency. Mayor Dunafon read the matter into the record by title only, all Council Members having received copies of the same. Deputy City Manager, Chuck Line, explained this ordinance will expedite the procedure for restaurants to temporarily modify their premises to allow for social distancing during the pandemic. Council Member Mintz motioned to approve the ordinance. Council Member Tuchscherer seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.
